



The Netherlands has supplied its military with contract boxes from various manufactures in Europe. The boxes here are not listed in any order.

- S-1 **.22 SHORT.** "UBUNGSPATRONE ZWEITE-WAHI". Produced by Gevelot of France. Unbleached box with black printing. One-piece box with end flaps. "GG-5" h/s on a copper case. Lead bullet.

- S-2 **.22 SHORT.** "PALRONEN SCHERPE". Produced by Gevelot of France. Red and cream box with black printing. One-piece box with end flaps. Contents are unknown.

- S-3 **.22 SHORT.** Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. Top states HARTBLE. White box without printing. White, wrap-around end label with black printing. Large, one-piece box with end flaps. "R-8" h/s on a nickel washed brass case. Lead bullet.


Misc. MILITARY Issues

- LR-1 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. White box with black printing. Large one-piece box with end flaps. No product code. "R-8" h/s on a copper case. Lead bullet. This box probably produced during WW II.
- LR-2 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** Produced by Winchester of the U.S.A. This is a standard 1930s or 1940s style box with a over-label. Blue label with black printing. "H-10" h/s on a nickel washed brass case. Copper washed lead bullet.
- LR-3 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** "BALL, LONG". Produced by I.C.I. of England. White box with black printing. One-piece box with end flaps."IC-3" h/s on a brass case. Lead bullet.
- LR-4 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** "BALL, LONG RIFLE". Manufactured by R.W.S. of Germany during the 1950s. This is a standard commercial box with a buff over-label with black printing.
- LR-5 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. White box. Kraft colored wrap-around end label with black printing. Large, one-piece box with end flaps. "R-8" h/s on a brass case. Lead bullet.
- LR-6 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** This is the same box as LR-5 except a white wrap-around end label.
- LR-7 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** Produced by R.W.S. of Germany white box. Yellow wrap-around end label with black printing. Large, one piece box with end flaps. Contents are unknown.
- LR-8 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. White box. Orange wrap-around end label with black printing. Large, one piece box with end flaps. "R-8" h/s on a nickel washed brass case. Lead bullets. Dates from 74-1 to 82-1 noted.







- LR-8.2 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** "AO86" White one-piece box with buff over-label with black printing.. "R" h/s on a nickel case.
- LR-8.4 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** ."AO86" White one-piece box with buff over-label with black printing.. "R" h/s on a nickel case.
- LR-8.6 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** ."AO86" Same as LR-8.4 but different lot number.
- LR-8.8 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** ."AO86" Same as LR-8.4 but different lot number. And over-label color
- LR-9 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** Produced by I.C.I. of England. Box of 100. White label with black printing. Kraft, two-piece, full cover box. Full wrap-around end label. Contents are unknown.
- LR-10 **.22 LONG RIFLE.** Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. White box. White label with black printing. Full wrap-around end label. Large, one-piece box with end flaps."R-8" h/s on a brass case. Lead bullet.






Misc. MILITARY Issues

- LR-11 **.22 LONG RIFLE (TRACER)**. Produced by S.F.M. of France. White label with red printing. One-piece box with end flaps. Over-stamped in green ink LEUCHTSPUR. "GG-6" h/s on a nickel washed brass case. Red tipped lead bullet.
- LR-12 **.22 LONG RIFLE (TRACER)**. Same as LR-11 except over-stamped in red ink.
- LR-13 **.22 LONG RIFLE (TRACER)**. Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. White box. White label with black printing. Large, one-piece box with end flaps. "R-8" h/s on a nickel washed brass case. Red tipped lead bullet.
- LR-14 **.22 LONG RIFLE**. Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. White box. White full wrap-around end label with black printing. Large, one-piece box with end flaps. Contents are unknown.
- LR-15 **.22 LONG RIFLE**. Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. White box. Buff label with black printing. Full wrap-around end label. Large, one-piece box with end flaps. "R-8" h/s on a brass case. Lead bullet.
- LR-16 **.22 LONG RIFLE**. Same as LR-15 except a different format to the label.
- LR-17 **.22 LONG RIFLE**. Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. Top states FUR EINZELLADEWAFFER (for single loading). White box with black printing. Large, one-piece box with end flaps. "R-8" h/s on a nickel washed brass case. Lead bullets. Lots noted 9-58 to 48-59. (lot 48-59 has brass cases).
- LR-18 **.22 LONG RIFLE**. Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. Top states SCHIESSKINOANLAGEN (for show or display). Buff label with black printing. Large, one-piece box with end flaps. Contents are unknown, but may be dummies.





- LR-19 **.22 LONG RIFLE (TRACER)**. Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. Top states NOT TO BE FIRED WITH MG .30 SUB CAL. White label with black printing. Large, one-piece box with end flaps. "R-8" h/s on a nickel washed brass case. Red tipped lead bullet.
- LR-20 **.22 LONG RIFLE (TRACER)**. Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. Top states LEUCHTSPUR (Tracer). White box with black printing. Large, one-piece box with end flaps. "R-8" h/s on a nickel washed brass case. Red tipped lead bullet. Lots noted 68-5 to 71-6.
- LR-21 **.22 LONG RIFLE**. Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. Top states FUR SELBST UND EINZELLADER (for auto and Single loaders). This is a commercial box from the 1960s. White over-label with black printing. Contents are unknown.
- LR-22 **.22 LONG RIFLE (BLANK)**. Produced by R.W.S. of Germany. Top states TREIBBLASIANGS ZUNDER (flame thrower ignition cartridges). White box with black printing. Large, one-piece box with end flaps. "R-8" h/s on a rose crimped brass case.
